In 1909, Congress passed the 16th Amendment, which allowed the federal government to tax individual personal income. Since 1950, individual income taxes have been the primary source of revenue for the U.S. federal government.

If you don't pay your tax bill in full by tax day, whether you file an extension or not, you'll pay a penalty. On top of that, you may be assessed interest on top of any tax and penalties due on April 15. (If your income was less than \$69,000 in 2019, you can file your federal tax return for free. The IRS lists different tax preparers on its [Free File Lookup tool](#), including [H&R Block](#) and [TurboTax](#)).
